- **Ensure long term system integrity**
- **Provide worker safety enhancements**
- **Protect tank from seismic activity**
- **Maintain tank external aesthetics**

The City of Kirkland will be improving the North Reservoir to ensure long-term system integrity, to provide worker safety enhancements, and protect the tank during any future seismic activity.

**Who:** The City of Kirkland, along with its contractor, Ebenal General, Inc., will be performing this Capital Improvements Program Project.

**What:** Significant seismic upgrades, new worker safety railing and fall protection, rain gutters, new interior tank protective coating/lining, new exterior tank painting, new painted tree mural.

**When:** Work is expected to start the first part of August and continue through to April, 2010. Typical hours of construction operation are Monday – Friday, 7:00 am to 5:00 pm.

**What to Expect:** During construction, there should be only minor impacts on Mark Twain Park patrons as the existing fenced yard surrounding the tank will protect the public from the work zone. The contractor will routinely use the access road by the tank and there will be times when many types of construction equipment will be in operation. There will be periods of typical and loud construction noise, however, these periods will be during normal daytime working hours – no nighttime or weekend work is planned at this time.

**How You Can Help:** Please call 911 if you see suspicious activities in and around the work zone at night or on weekends.
